

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the undersigned parties, that,

1. If called to testify as a witness, Scott Schools, former Department of Justice Associate Deputy Attorney General, would testify that what has been marked for identification as Defense Exhibit 557 is a true and accurate copy of handwritten notes taken by him during a meeting that occurred on March 6, 2017. He would further testify that during the March 6, 2017 meeting, senior members of the FBI briefed the Department of Justice's Acting Attorney General about various aspects of the FBI's investigations into potential Russian influence in the 2016 presidential election.

2. Additionally, Mr. Schools would testify that he recalls taking notes contemporaneously during the meeting and that the notes accurately reflect what he was told at the time. He would further testify that he cannot recall the substance of what occurred in the meeting or who specifically attended the meeting independently from what is written in his notes. Based on his notes, Mr. Schools would testify that the meeting attendees included himself, Trisha Anderson, James Baker, James Rybicki, Carl Ghattas, Andrew McCabe, Peter Strzok, Bill Priestap, George Toscas, Mary McCord, Tashina Gauhar, Dana Boente, Jim Crowell, and Richard

Scott.

3. This stipulation, marked as Government Exhibit 2204, is admissible in evidence at trial.
