We are happy to participate in a briefing with either the DNC and/or Crowd Strike. The DNC is a victim of a crime and we generally do not disclosure information about the nature of the computer intrusion to other parties. I do recognize HFA and other Democratic campaigns could very well be impacted by the DNC matter and as such I am comfortable with participating in a briefing. Just want to make sure you are fully on-board with that and we talk about how much information is disclosed.
